- POSITION** Part-time Accompanist for Music Voice/Instrumental Majors. Begins fall semester, 2010. May combine with other teaching positions, such as class piano/piano instructor (see other postings).
- RESPONSIBILITIES** Serve as principal accompanist for vocal music majors. Please note: most responsibilities will be carried out the latter part of the semester. Duties include the following:
- Accompany lessons and rehearsal with each vocalist (approx. 8 weeks)
 - Accompany each vocalist at Department recitals and studio classes*
 - Accompany 1 jury performance for each vocalist at end of semester
- * Accompanist must be available during Department/ Studio recital hour at 2:00 pm on selected Tuesdays.
- The Department Accompanist may be requested to accompany instrumental students on an as-needed basis (an additional hourly fee will be paid by the student).
- QUALIFICATIONS** A demonstrated mastery of piano skills. Extensive experience as a collaborative performer. Must be able to sight-read proficiently.
- SALARY** Salary at per student rate.
- DEPARTMENT** The Bethany College Music Department has been accredited by NASM since 1935. The department has 4 full-time faculty members, approximately 30 majors and 120 music participants.
