RESPONSIBILITIES	<p>Teach: AR100 Introduction to Visual Art (3 hr.) This course is taken as General Education credit by non-art majors. The course focuses on the study of the functions and styles of the world of visual art both past and present; an analysis of the structure, media, themes, and categories within visual art; an investigation into the processes utilized in the creation of artworks, as well as, the formal elements and principles of good design. Students will also study non-western, as well as, western styles of art making.
