**POSITION**

Assistant Professor of Education (Secondary)  
Full-time, tenure track, beginning August 12, 2012.

**RESPONSIBILITIES:**

The successful candidate will teach courses at the undergraduate level within the Education Department including Educational Psychology, Foundations of Education, and Secondary Teaching Strategies. Candidates must possess knowledge of pedagogical methods and be competent in the use of technology. Expectations include mentoring and supervising student teachers, active recruitment, advising students, student assessment, creating and maintaining partnerships with public schools and strong interpersonal skills. In addition the successful candidate will establish positive relationships with content faculty in the Education Department in order to support all areas of assessment activities including the KSDE program review process. Participation in program reviews at the state and national levels, and other duties as assigned will be expected.

Bethany College partners with the John Gardner Foundations of Excellence program, and the individual assuming this position is expected to provide excellent teaching in particular for first year students.

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

An earned doctorate in education or a Master's Degree and evidence of exemplary teaching in public education; a minimum of 3 years of teaching experience in a public school in the United States. The successful candidate must have a commitment to liberal arts education. Preference will be given to those with knowledge of KSDE/NCATE accreditation standards and processes; grant-writing experience; the development of innovative practices and successful experiences in working with diverse populations.

**SALARY**

Salary based on qualifications and experience.

The Education Department at Bethany College is one of the largest departments on campus. The department offers majors in Social Studies, Math, Biology, Chemistry, Business, Music, Health and P.E., Art, English.
