POSITION	Part-time Instructor in Social Psychology. Begins with the Spring of 2012.
RESPONSIBILITIES	Primary responsibility is to teach one section of Social Psychology (3 hour course) as part of the Psychology Major to college students. Enrollment runs 15 to 25. This course is designed to study of the effect of social stimuli on behavior. Major topics considered are attraction, aggression, attitude formation, conformity, altruism, person perception, prejudice, culture and social class, and sex role differences. Secondary responsibility is to support the mission of Bethany College.
QUALIFICATIONS	Master's in Psychology or related field is required. Teaching experience at the college level is also required.
SALARY	\$600 per credit hour
DEPARTMENT	The Psychology Department is usually made up of two full-time faculty members and one or two part-time instructors per semester. It provides courses for the Psychology Major as well as for the Teacher Education and General Education programs.
