Full-time tenure-track faculty in Organic Chemistry and Biochemistry.

**RESPONSIBILITIES
& EXPECTATIONS**

An enthusiastic, student- and learning-centered approach to teaching is required, and research-based best practices in education and assessment are expected. Primary responsibilities are to teach the Organic Chemistry I & II sequence with laboratories, a one-semester Biochemistry course with laboratory, General Chemistry I & II with laboratories, and Introductory Chemistry courses as needed. Other responsibilities include student advising and mentoring, active participation in recruitment of students, continued professional development, and participation in Departmental and campus committees. The development of an undergraduate research program is encouraged, but not required.

Bethany College partners with the John Gardner Foundations of Excellence program, and the individual assuming this position is expected to provide excellent teaching and advising in particular for first year students.

QUALIFICATIONS

A Ph.D. in Organic Chemistry or a related field is required; ABD will be considered. Teaching experience at the college level is very helpful.

SALARY

Contingent upon qualifications.

DEPARTMENT

This position is in the Science Department. The department provides majors in biology, chemistry, forensic science, biology teaching, and chemistry teaching. The courses taught by the faculty member in this position are required for these majors, and are options for non-majors seeking general education requirements.
